CHAIRMAN'S NOTE NOVEMBER 2012

Chairman's Note November 2012

Much has happened since my April 2012 note, so I will briefly summarize some new LNN activities. We held the fourth "Nano for Business" conference at Lehigh in May in collaboration with Drexel, and hope that those of you who attended enjoyed the networking and information that were offered. This continues to be a well-attended event and we look forward to the next one in 2014. Nano for Business was followed closely by another conference - PA Nano 2012. Presented by the six major PA research universities, and hosted by Harrisburg University, this event drew nearly 100 attendees and included speakers from nanotechnology companies, universities, and federal and state agencies. Holding this in Harrisburg helps to communicate the role of the LNN and other PA organizations that support nanotechnology businesses to state legislators and funding sources, and reinforces Pennsylvania's commitment to nanotechnology as a component of economic growth.

The LNN mission statement includes promotion of workforce development and education, and we have continued to link our Sustaining Members with university engineering and science student interns. These positions are subsidized by PA DCED funds through Lehigh's Center for Advanced Materials and Nanotechnology. This past summer, interns were selected by Applied Separations, BioSample Solutions, Custom Processing Services, and Monodnock Non-Wovens. We intend to continue this benefit in 2013 and invite you to apply.

In addition, the LNN Executive Board has authorized sponsorship of two modest awards for high school students participating in STEM competitions. In 2013, these include PA Technology Student Association (PATSA) Science Competition and the Berks Science Fair. If you know of a deserving organization for this type of support, let us know and we will include it in the tion process.

In May we also passed the 200 mark for LNN membership. In fact we are currently at 210, with 41 Sustaining Members, and the growth continues. We will celebrate this milestone at our next meeting on January 25 at Ben Franklin TechVentures on Lehigh University's campus. Our goal is to increase the relevance and rewards of LNN membership, and your input and participation is key.
